Course Details

We have 3 intakes which begin in **January**May and **September** every year.



Participants are expected to attend 3 half day workshops. You can choose to attend these over 3 consecutive months or a longer period of time to fit in with your working lives.

The workshops are held at each of the 4 Trust sites, and you can pick and choose where you attend.

In between workshops there are 1 to 1 coaching sessions to support you during the Programme to enable you to keep on track with your improvement idea.



At the end of each year we hold a Sharing Event at one of the Trust sites. You will produce a poster to showcase the great work you have done towards your improvement.



There will be a presentation of Certificates to each participant by a member of the Executive Team.



For your future development following completion of the QI Programme, there will be opportunities to apply for the QSIR (Quality, Service Improvement and Redesign) course.




