Out of 10 responses:

- 8 (80%) are **POSITVE**
- 2 (20%) are NEUTRAL

Key themes identified by those who feel the restoration of services will be **positive** (multiple topics discussed in individual responses from members of the public):

- 6 (75%) Transport concerns (long journeys, time consuming, public transport not great)
- 3 (38%) Moving chemo back to Lincoln and Boston will reduce anxiety and stress for patients
- **3 (38%)** need to restore service to serve Grantham's growing population/ benefits to the local economy / recruitment
- 1 (1%) Patients having to wait hours for transfers to Lincoln due to UTC not being equipped to treat them

Key themes identified by those who feel the restoration of services will be **neutral** include (multiple topics discussed in individual responses from members of the public):

- 1 (50%) Clinics appointments have only been marginally amended current experience is good
- 1 (50%)Would like labour ward and maternity and children's ward reinstated
