Main Duties:					
<p>This is a post in Anaesthesia and Critical Care Medicine based between Theatres or the Intensive Care Unit. There will be the opportunity to gain an understanding learning of General & Regional anaesthesia, learn basic airway management and experience advanced techniques, venous cannulation, an understanding of perioperative pain management and the pharmacology of anaesthetic agents. Within the confines of critical care experience can be gained in dealing with critically ill patients from different disciplines, perfecting an A to E assessment, and understanding the application of human physiology to supporting people in an advanced fashion. There may be opportunity to learn to put in arterial, central venous and midlines and learn about advanced ventilator strategies, renal replacement therapy, end of life decision making and delivery. The time in both theatre and intensive care is fully supported at all times by senior doctors. There may be opportunity to participate in audit/QI projects. Generally week blocks are spent either in ICU or theatres.</p>
