The F1 post is based in Boston, community. This post provides four days per week experience in General Adult Out-patient Psychiatry, for a busy catchment area. The F1 will be encouraged to see follow up patients under supervision. The expectation is for a Foundation Year 1 trainee to see 2-3 patients/clinic. The medical team comprises of a full time Consultant Psychiatrist (Dr Mithilesh Jha) and one Specialty Doctor.

In addition to Out-Patient Clinics, the F1 will also work 2 session/wk in CMHT clinic under supervision. They will be exposed to multi-faceted presentation of complex mental disorders and will experience the impact of psychosocial stressor on a vulnerable individual and will learn various treatment modalities that LPFT offers.

Boston CMHT prides itself on its multi-disciplinary team approach to patient care and, in addition to the above medical staff; we have a full contingent of junior and senior nursing staff, occupational therapy, and access to specialist psychology.
