#### **Main Duties:**

#### **Job Description**

- Observation of the consultant performing patient assessments in the outpatient clinic
- Exposure to the assessment and treatment of complex psychiatric problems in people with ID
- Exposure to the assessment and treatment of epilepsy
- Assessment and investigation of physical healthcare problems for community patients as necessary
- Attendance at the weekly ID team meeting where patient problems are discussed, and new referrals considered
- Weekly general psychiatry case presentations and journal clubs in the Postgraduate Programme
- LD case presentations and ID audit presentations
- Training in autism, challenging behaviour, epilepsy, and dementia from Dr Speight as required
- Observation of the consultant interviewing people with communication difficulties, and the opportunity to then conduct such interviews.
- Opportunity to complete an audit
- To take a full psychiatric history from a patient with a learning disability and their carer/support worker
- To document a full mental state examination of a patient with ID
- To develop an understanding of capacity and consent issues in people with ID, particularly in relation to the Mental Capacity Act
- To be able to assess a patient with ID who also has a mental health disorder
- To accurately assess the physical healthcare needs of a patient with ID who has a concurrent psychiatric disorder
- To liaise with the patient's GP and organise appropriate medical investigations as appropriate (e.g. blood tests, ECG, etc)
- To design and carry out an audit
- To understand the various roles and responsibilities of other members of the multidisciplinary team
- To develop expertise in interviewing patients with communication difficulties
- To liaise with the patient and their carer/support worker before deciding on appropriate treatment of psychiatric disorder
- To initiate simple psychiatric medical treatments under direct consultant supervision
- To gain an understanding of challenging behaviour
